Traffic

The road outside Mallmore and the Town Hall can get very busy!

Within activity times, children will be closely supervised as they cross the road.

However, the most dangerous times are before and after activities.

Please therefore:

- ✓ cross the road at the designated point, as directed by the "road crossing" team member (wearing a hi-visibility vest)
- ✓ instruct children arriving by bike or scooter not to ride on the pavement near Mallmore, and to leave their bike/scooter in the Mallmore garden, not on the pavement
- ✗ do not double park, or stop on the grass verge near Mallmore or the Town Hall

Swimming

We are not insured or legally qualified to supervise swimming in the sea.

We will not allow swimming during activities, and are unable to take responsibility for children or teenagers who go in swimming at any other time.



Be prepared

Activities take place both inside and outside, and can sometimes be messy....

Please ensure children have comfortable footwear and come equipped for the variations in Manx weather!



Photos and videos

During Beach Mission, photos and videos may be taken by children and young people, team members, or other staff and volunteers of Scripture Union. Photos and videos may be used in group sessions, on social media, or in SU promotional literature (in which names will never be used). If you do not wish your child to be videoed or photographed, please notify us in writing.

Registration

All children and teenagers must be registered!

This is to ensure the safety of your child, and to provide us with all relevant information including emergency contact details.

It will be a huge help to us if you can complete and return the registration form BEFORE BEACH MISSION BEGINS.

At Beach Mission, ALL children are valued and included. If your child has any additional needs, it would be very helpful for us to know about this in advance, so that we can ensure that we provide the best possible care and support for them.

Collecting your children

- Please ensure that your child always knows who, if anyone, will collect them.
- Please collect your child promptly.
- If you are unavoidably delayed, please phone 435153.
- Children who will be collected by an older brother or sister must have permission on their registration form to leave without an adult.
- Note that the groups have slightly different finishing times, and that Deckers finish later than the children's groups in the mornings and evenings.
- For safety reasons, no child or teenager will be allowed to leave a session early unaccompanied, unless we have received a signed note from a parent or guardian.



Costs

There will be a small charge for outings, to cover costs, but all other activities are free of charge.

Our activities are funded entirely from donations from Churches, parents, and friends of the mission.
